Abdelghani Alnahawi creates installations and performances from found objects and urban fragments. In his workshops, participants will play with found objects and everyday materials to build small sculptures that express care and empathy.



Ana Escobar Saavedra works across textiles, metal, and mixed media to explore the emotional and material relationships between people and objects. In her workshops, participants will shape and transform materials while exploring the special connection between people and the objects they treasure.



Arnold Barretto combines photography, printmaking, and bookmaking to explore identity, space, and personal narratives. In his workshops, participants will dive into printmaking and photography using their hands as tools to create images that reflect their own identity.



Fatima Uzdenova antidisciplinary practice spans sculpture, performance, and mixed media. In her workshops participants will combine drawing, collage, and other mixed media to explore nature, growth, and the idea of the garden as both sanctuary and story.



Nada Almosa works with photography, mixed media, and creative writing to explore memory, identity, and play. In her workshops participants will use photography and creative writing to capture personal memories and turn overlooked moments into meaningful art.



Nagham Hammoush combines
printmaking, performance, and
participatory projects to explore
memory, rhythm, and lived experience.
In her workshops, participants will
experiment with repeated patterns and
simple printing techniques to reflect on
movement, memory, and rhythm.

## DROP - IN STUDIO PROGRAMME

Drop-In Studio is designed for people of all ages to casually experiment with an easy to follow, designed art activity and create artworks at their own pace. Prior booking is required. Children aged 8 years old and under should be accompanied by an adult at all times in the Drop-in Studio.

A wide variety of drawing and painting supplies are provided along-side books and other educational resources for visitors to browse through for inspiration and guidance.
